


HOMEWORK: YEAR 3

<p>Readiwriter Spelling</p>	<p>Login to Readiwriter Spelling by visiting the following website: https://login.readiwriter.com/. Enter your Mathletics login details. There are word lists which follow rules we have been learning. Try to login in a times a week to improve your spelling.</p>  <p>Start by selecting a spelling rule on the left-hand side and then work your way around the tiles. Begin by reminding yourself of the learning statement by clicking on the motivate tile. Afterwards, you can master the spellings and then deepen your learning in the magnify section.</p>
